

Walk 3 - Greywell Hill and Butter Wood

1 Hour

Beginning at the Fox and Goose, turn left and walk up the Hook Road for 30 metres and turn left at a footpath sign by a gate. This takes you beside the pub field and the north side of the 'Dell' (a disused mud pit) and up to a stile at the bottom of the large field in front of Greywell Hill House. ON crossing the stile you bear sharp right and follow the bottom of the field until you come to the stile, which provides access to the woods. Cross this stile and go up through the wood. After about 100 metres it joins a bridleway running down the hill.



Cross straight over the bridleway and follow the path opposite. This area of Butter Wood has splendid beeches and oaks. You should continue straight on following the yellow arrows, until you almost reach the motorway cutting, which is right down the hill by some wooden huts. Here you keep a straight line down the hill keeping the motorway to your left.

Eventually you turn right along another path, following the arrows, which run along the edge of an open field. Follow it along the west side of the field before joining a wider grassy ride that runs along the bottom of the wood. After 10 minutes walking you get to a gate at 'Nap Pond'. To complete the walk you should pass through the gap beside the gate and take the cinder track down the hill to Hook Road. Turn right and follow the road back to the Fox and Goose.
